BY-LAW NO. 198/2018

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

By-law No. 198/2018 proposes to amend the Town's Land Use By-law to add definitions for recreational cannabis, medical cannabis, production and retail sales, etc.

Please note: By-law No. 198/2018 adds the definitions for cannabis to the Land Use By-law, it does not add the use, production or sale to any land use district.

Public Input:

A Public Hearing for By-law No. 198/2018 will be held Tuesday, May 8, 2018, at 7:00 pm, at the Bentley Town Office, 4918 – 50th Street, Bentley, AB.

Persons wishing to speak will be requested to state their name and address for the record upon being recognized by the Chairperson. Town Council will consider submissions made in person or by agent from any person who claims to be affected by the proposed by-law.

Any person wishing to submit written comments may do so by sending them to the Town of Bentley, Box 179, Bentley, AB or may submit in person at 4918 – 50th Avenue, prior to 4:00 pm on May 7, 2018.
